

SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY

Are you out of work because of an injury or illness?

You may be eligible for Social Security Disability Benefits if you have a medical condition which has kept you out of work.

Did you know:

You can get Social Security Disability at any age.

You can receive retroactive or past due benefits for the time you have already missed from work, as well as monthly disability benefits.

You will be eligible for Medicare insurance if found to be disabled.

Individuals have been found disabled for many different and common conditions, including but not limited to:

Anxiety/Depression
Spinal pain
Migraine headaches
Heart conditions
Diabetes

Asthma
High Blood Pressure
Fibromyalgia
Carpal Tunnel Syndrome
Fatigue

You should apply as soon as you become disabled. Do not wait; you may lose money by waiting.

Do not exaggerate your conditions and be honest with our doctors. Medical records are very important evidence in your case. That is why you need to obtain necessary medical treatment for all of your health conditions, whether it be for physical conditions or a mental illness.

Social Security will most likely ask you to see a doctor of their choice, as well as requiring you to fill out questionnaires. It is my role as your attorney to help you with this.

If your initial claim is denied by Social Security, don't give up. This is the time to retain a lawyer like myself to represent you by pursuing an appeal of the denial where eventually your claim will be heard and decided by a Judge who only hears Social Security Disability cases.

Waiting for a hearing can take time. Hang in there since your chances of winning are greater with an attorney who knows the process.

It is wise to hire a lawyer who specializes in Social Security cases. The rules and regulations are complicated and change frequently. You need an attorney experienced in this area.
